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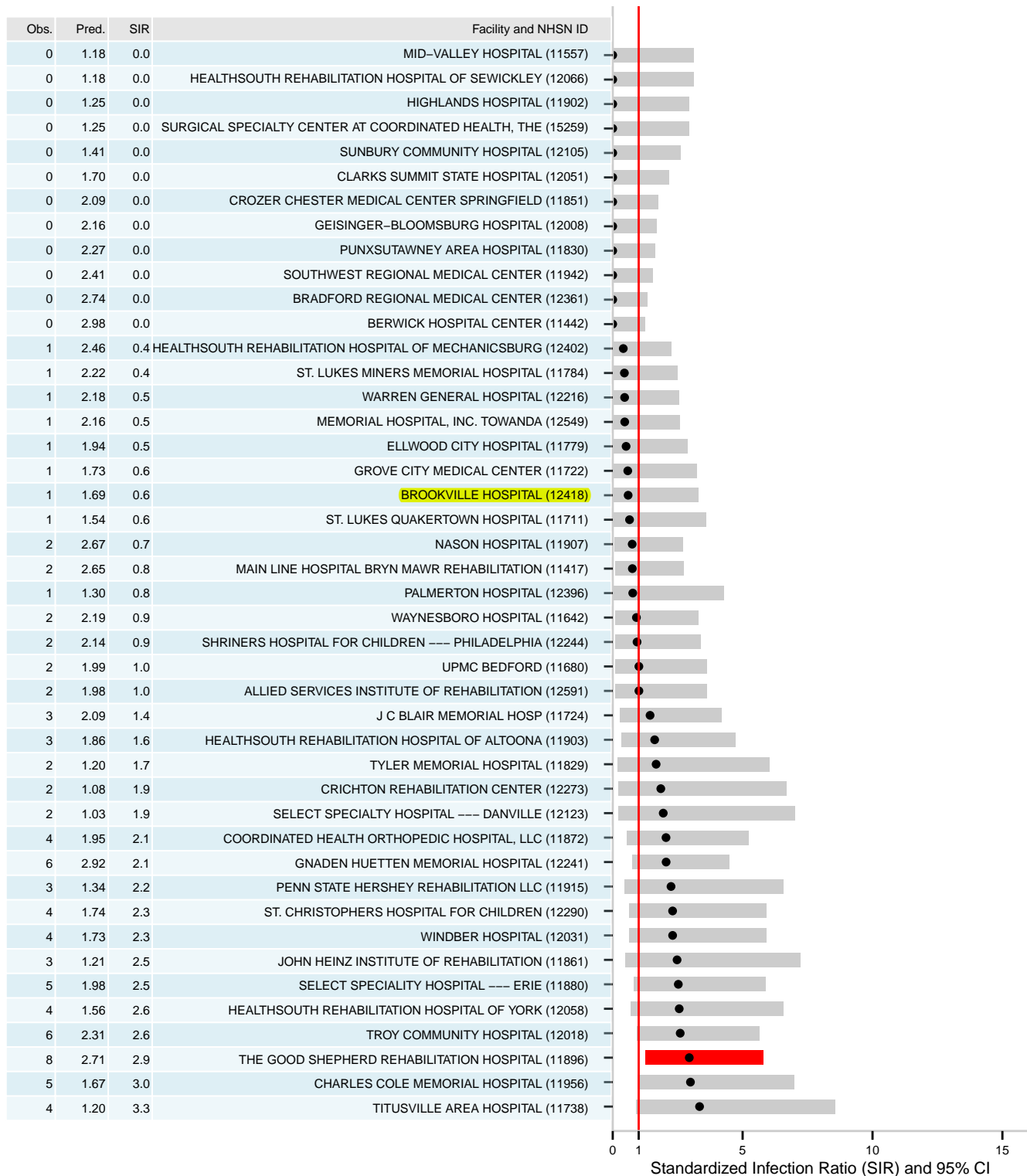

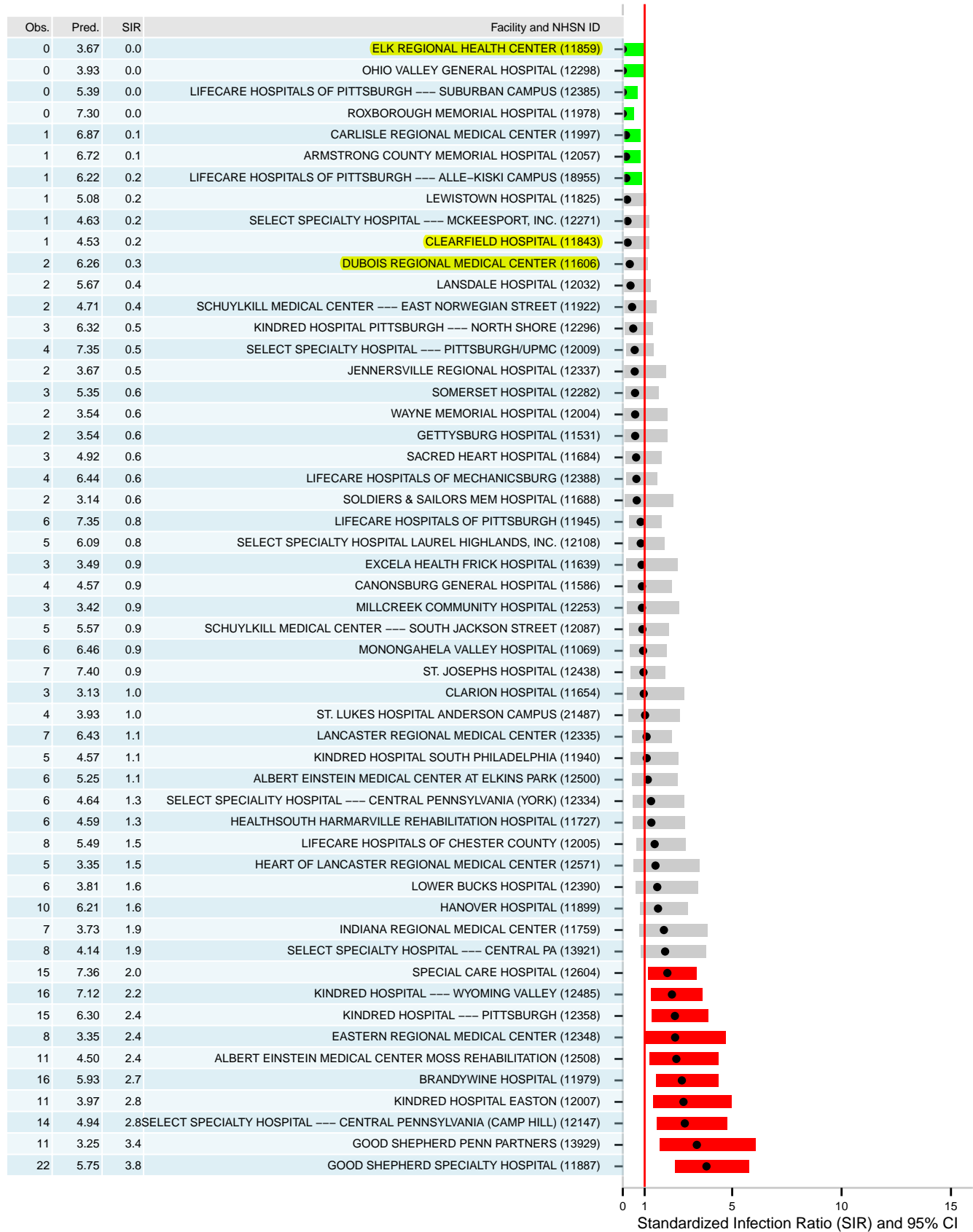

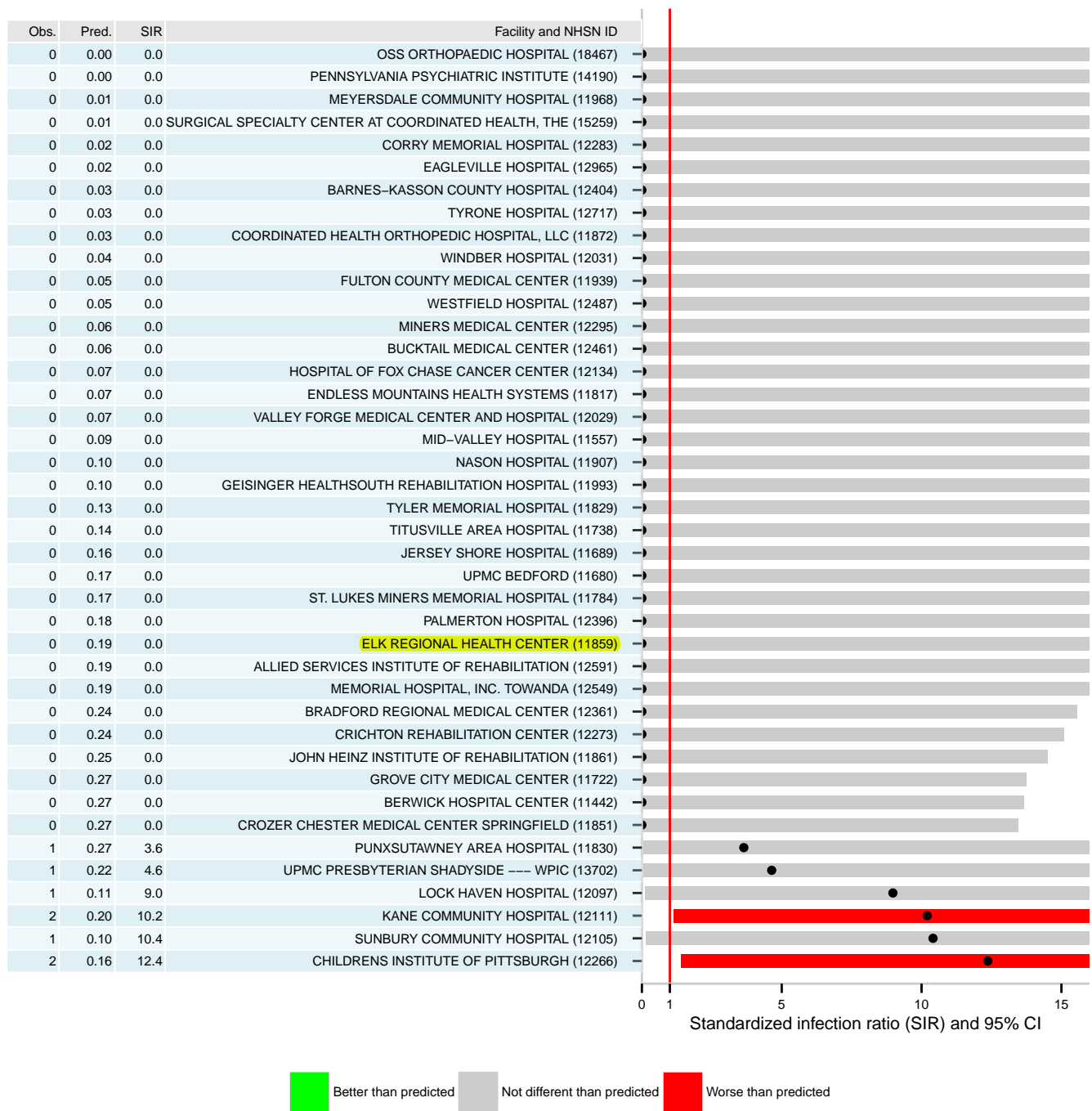


Figure 4.4.7: Critical Care Units and Wards: Number of Observed (Obs.) Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI) and Relative Ranking of Facilities by Standardized Infection Ratio (SIR) — Pennsylvania, 2012

Grouped by Number of Predicted (Pred.) Infections: 0.5–0.99

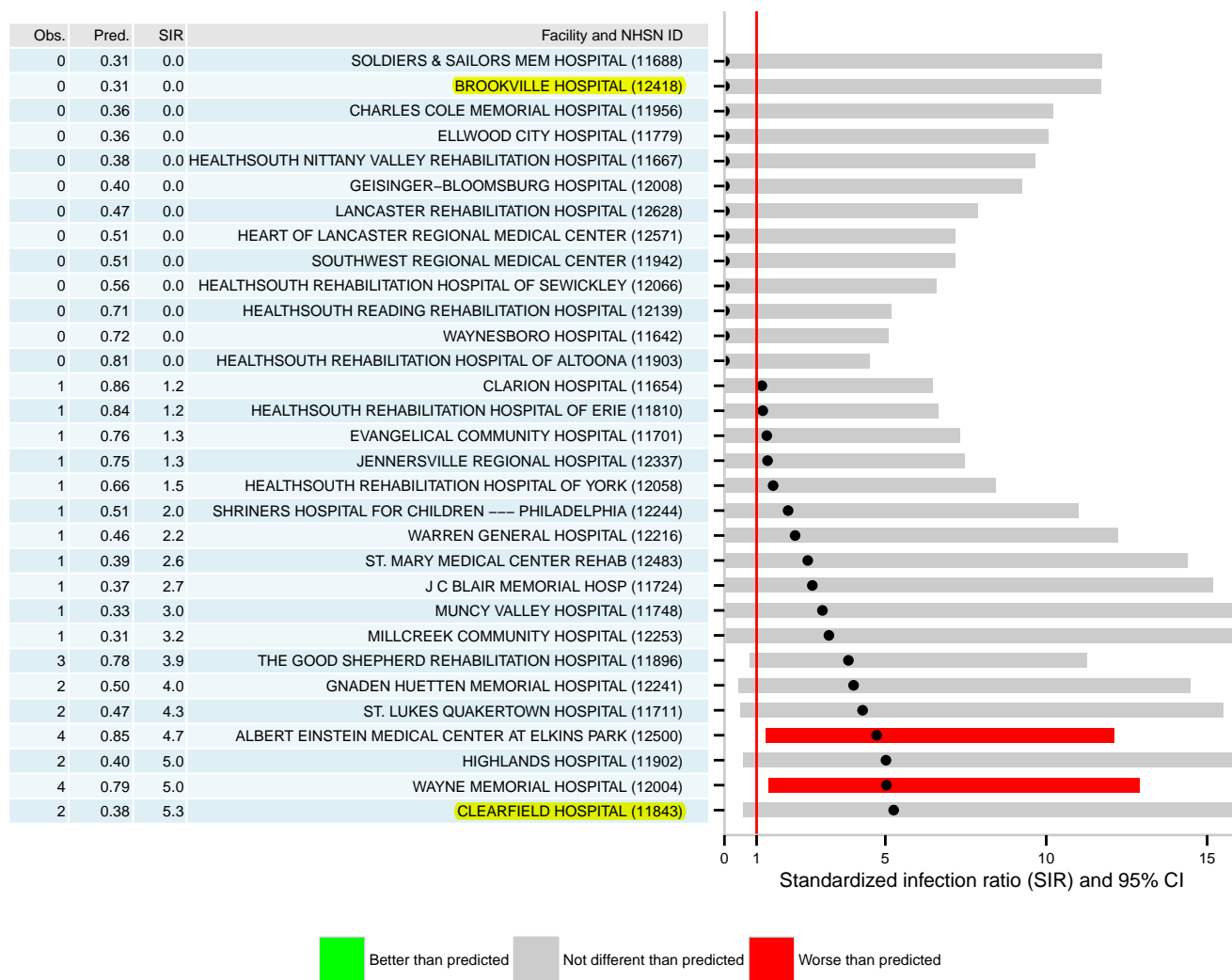


Figure 4.4.8: Critical Care Units and Wards: Number of Observed (Obs.) Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI) and Relative Ranking of Facilities by Standardized Infection Ratio (SIR) — Pennsylvania, 2012

Grouped by Number of Predicted (Pred.) Infections: 1–2.99

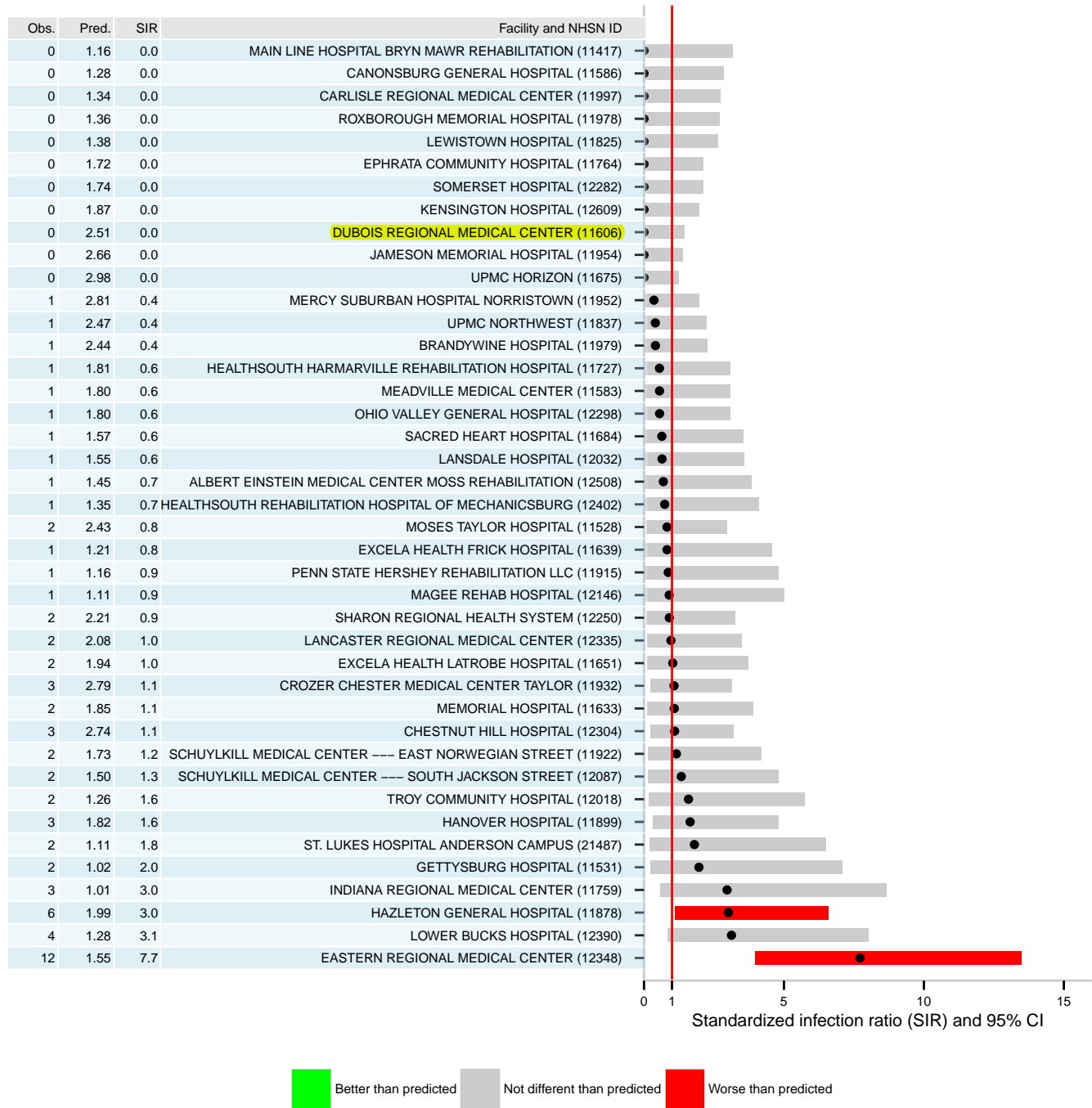


Figure 4.4.12: Neonatal Intensive Care Units: Number of Observed (Obs.) Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI) and Relative Ranking of Facilities by Standardized Infection Ratio (SIR) — Pennsylvania, 2012

Grouped by Number of Predicted (Pred.) Infections: < 1

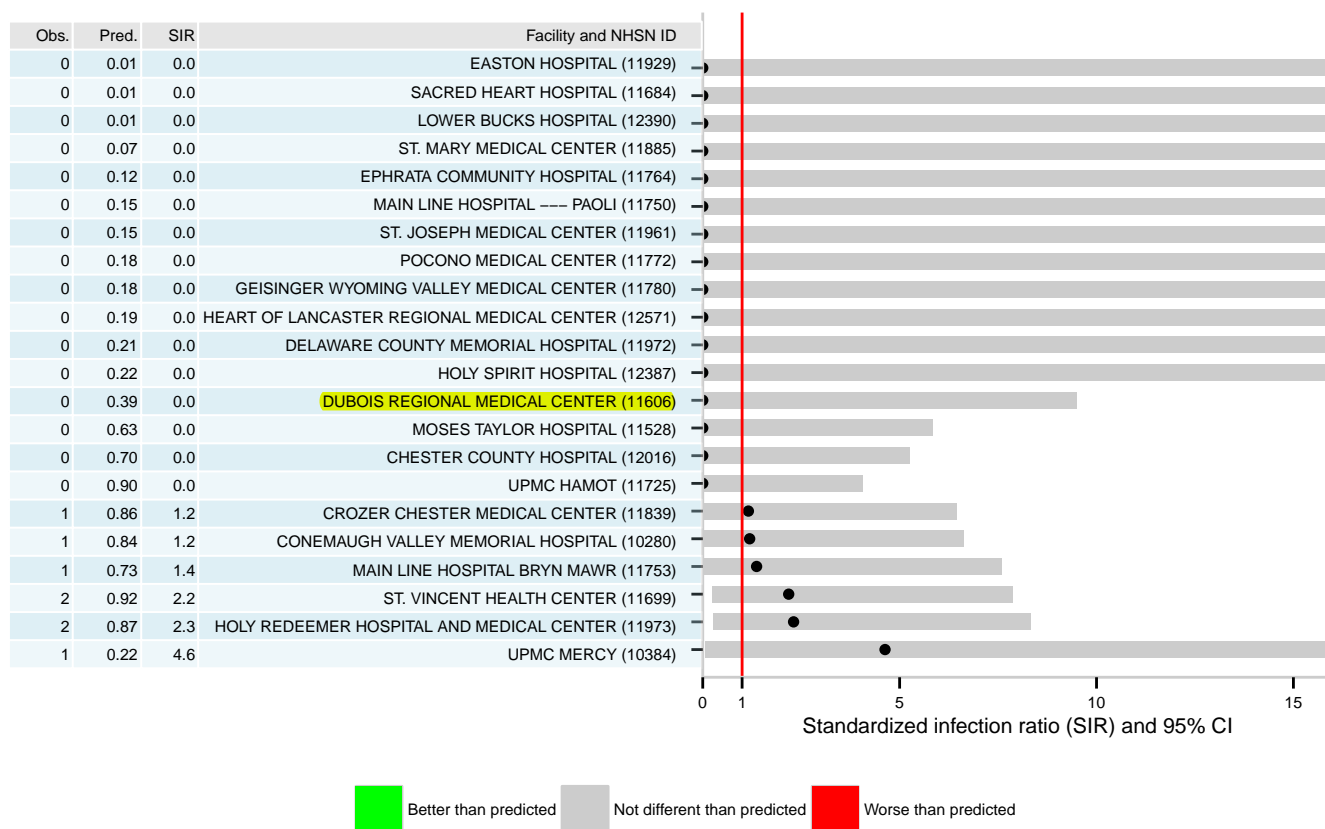

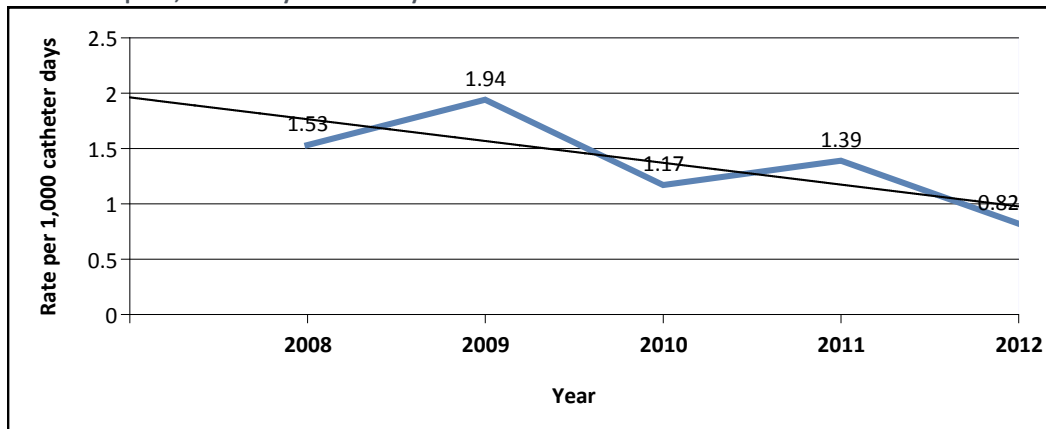

CAUTI Rate per 1,000 urinary catheter days



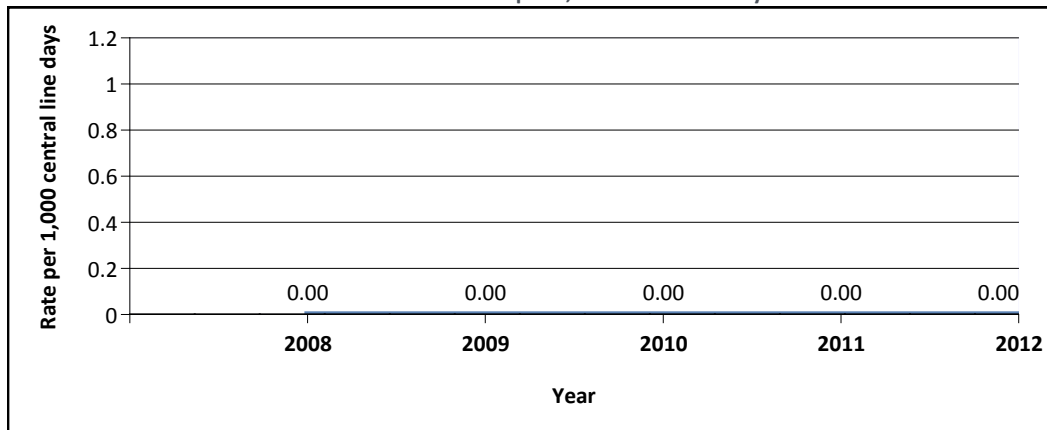

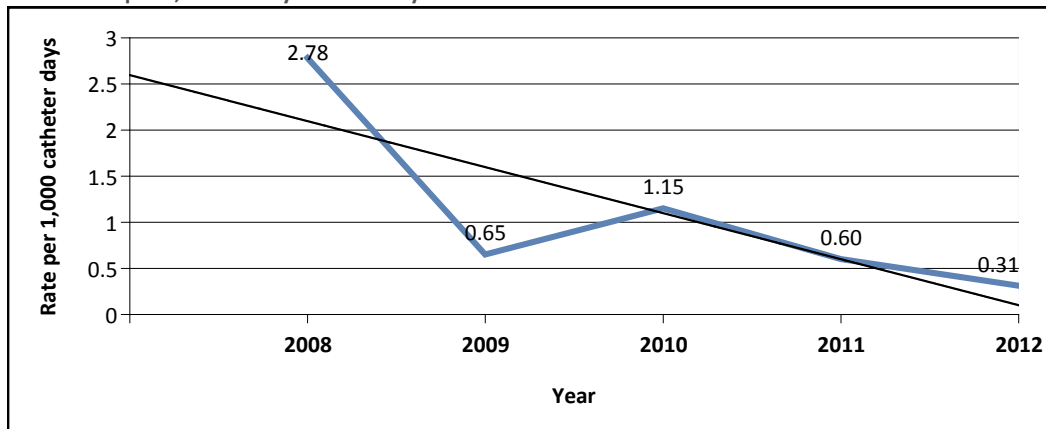

CAUTI Rate per 1,000 urinary catheter days



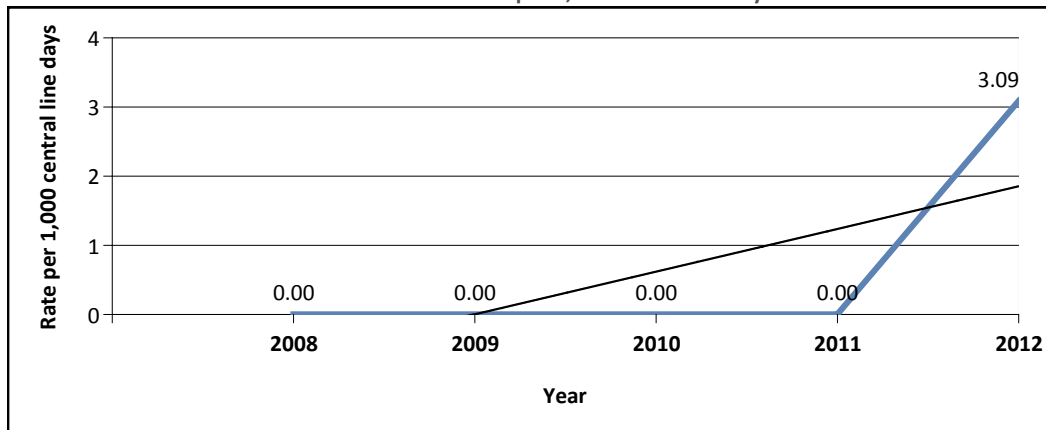

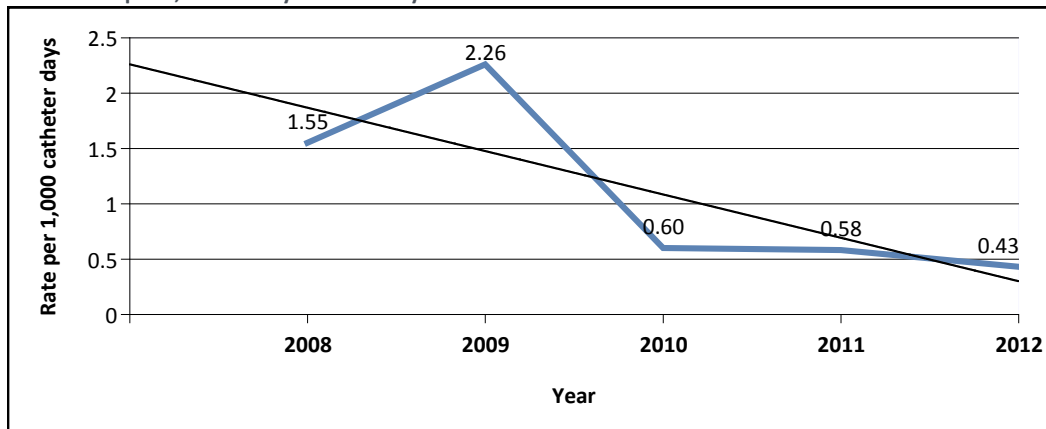

CAUTI Rate per 1,000 urinary catheter days



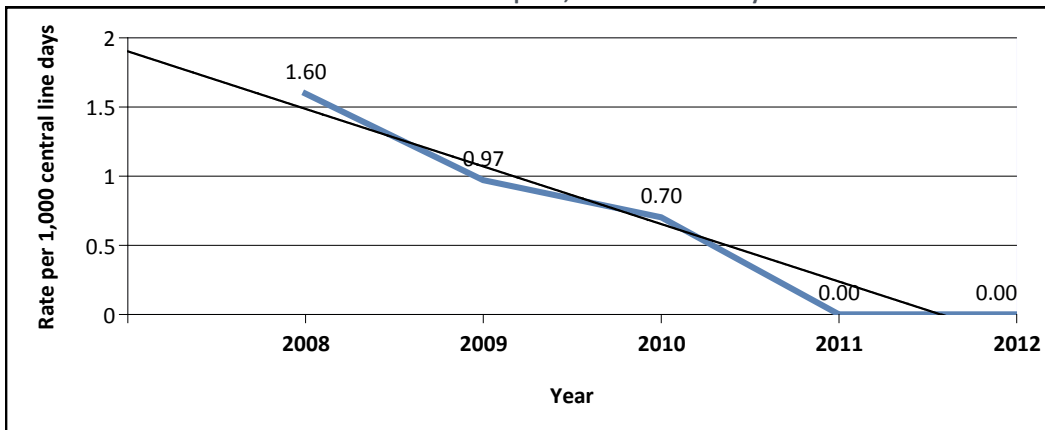

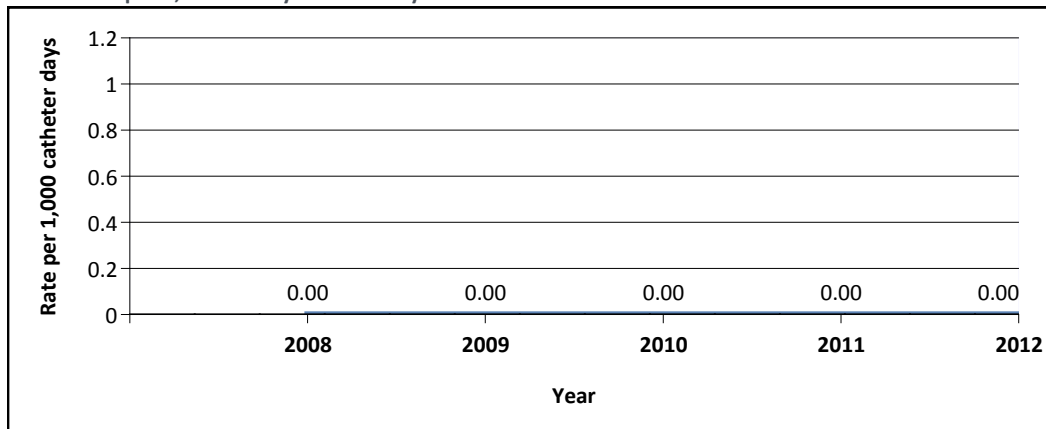
